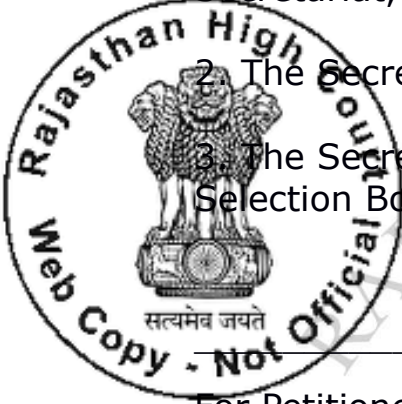

1. This writ petition has been preferred with the following
prayers:

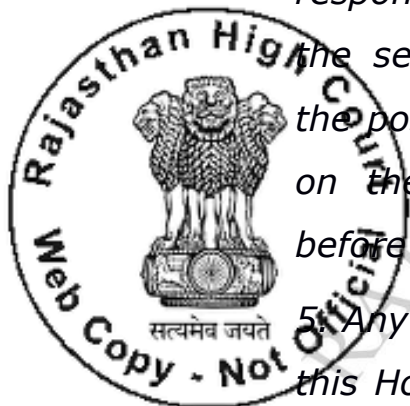
*"1. By an appropriate writ order or direction, any
order denying the selection and the appointment of
petitioner for the post of Patwari on the ground his
qualification i.e. RSCIT after acquiring the pre
examination in pursuance of the advertisement dated
04.11.2015 may kindly be quashed and set aside.*

*2. By an appropriate writ order or direction, the
respondents may kindly be directed to consider the
candidature of the petitioner for the post of Patwari as
per the qualification of RSCIT secured by him much
earlier than the date of main examination in
pursuance of the advertisement dated 04.11.2015.*

3. By an appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents may kindly be directed to permit the petitioner in further selection process and afford the petitioner appointment on the post of Patwari against his respective category, if he stands in merit with all consequential benefits.

4. By an appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents may kindly be directed to not to deny the selection and appointment of the petitioner for the post of Patwari and not to reject the candidature on the ground of required qualification of RSCIT before the date of pre examination.

5. Any other appropriate writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court deems just and proper may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner."



2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioner would be satisfied if his representation is considered and decided by the respondents.

3. In light of the statement of counsel for the petitioners, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondent to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner by a speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of 15 days from today.
