1. The petitioner by way of filing this petition is claiming
the following reliefs :-

*“a) by an appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents
be directed to give appointment to the petitioner on the post of
Teacher Grade III pursuant to the circular dated 18.1.2003 from
the date of his similarly situated candidates were given
appointment on the said post with all consequential benefits.*

b) Any other appropriate writ, order or direction which this

Hon`ble Court may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.

c) Writ petition filed by the petitioner may kindly be allowed with costs.”



At the outset, counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner shall be satisfied if his representation is decided by the respondents by passing a speaking within a stipulated time frame.

In view of the statement aforesaid, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide representation of the petitioner by passing a speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
